



# Elzetta ZFH1500 Limited Users Evaluation



- **During extensive training using the Elzetta tactical flashlight holder I found numerous positive findings. The holder was able with stand constant abuse that normally associated with combat related equipment. Time after time the barrel was operated at temperature well above normal operating temperature and the holder performed flawlessly.**
- **Versatility: The mount also proved to be very versatal when switching from multiple different weapon platforms.**
- **Storage and transportability: Very user friendly, even with the flashlight holder attached the weapon was still capable of fitting into a normal gun case, drag bag or rifle rack.**
- **Front end weight: Most flashlight adapters are normally made out of high quality aluminum and normally add additional front end weight. The narrow profile design along with the light weight material complimented the weapon system vice making it cumbersome.**
- **Functionality: I found attaching and detaching the light holder to be very easy with minimal moving parts. Added value was the ability to reconfigure the holder and capability to use different style slings.**
- **Ambidextrous use: Allows both handed shooters to configure the rifle to meet their specific needs. Additionally it allows the weapon to be carried in the cross body mode without having the rifle to be extracted from the weak side muzzle down.**
- **Care and cleaning: Even after the weapon was cleaned with normal cleaning solvents the attachment seemed to be resistant to the cleaning agents.**
- **Flaw: The attachment only can be used on weapon systems that incorporate a front sight post. Gas blocks and flip up sights are incorporated into most battle field weapons configurations.**
- **Final conclusion: The tactical light attachment has many unique benefits and should be considered as an optional piece of SL-3 equipment for the service rifle.**
